"I confess to Almighty God and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do; through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault. Therefore I ask blessed Mary, ever Virgin, all the angels and saints, and you, my brothers and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord our God."

In St. Paul's first letter to Corinth, he reminds the church that we are all united under the cross of Jesus, we are all one Body. He also reminds the church that, "If one part suffers, all the parts suffer with it; if one part is honored, all the parts share its joy." (1Cor 12:26). During our mediation on the Penitential Rite of the Holy Mass we are reminded of our need for Jesus as our Savior. That we can pray for each other but we also need to cast aside our pride and enter

humbly into the Sacrament of Reconciliation recognizing our sin as our own. We need to "work out our salvation with fear and trembling". (Phil 2:12) When we recognize the work we are called to do together, it is then we realize that as the Body of Christ, we overcome sin and the enemy with God's grace and healing. "For with the Lord is mercy, with Him is plenteous redemption." (Psalm 130:7) We do not journey the path to salvation alone. God's Peace,




Stewardship Financial Reports
