### 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time



"Let us pray" This phrase happens right after the Gloria is sung or recited. Often we think that the pause after this statement is so the priest can find his place in the Roman Missal. However, this is the time when we bring all those intentions to mind and mention them to God in the silence of our hearts. The silent pause is so everyone in the congregation has time to pray. This is why the opening prayer is called the Collect. After this period of silence the Church offers the individual prayers as one prayer to the Father, through the Son in the unity of the Holy Spirit. Notice, the Church, not the local parish, not the priest, the Church offers your prayer to God the Father. This would include the Church Triumphant, those in Heaven, the Church Suffering, those in purgatory, and the Church Militant, those on earth, the entire Church offers YOUR PRAYER to God the Father, through the Son, in the unity of the Holy Spirit. Remember weeks ago the emphasis on having an intention when one comes to the Holy Mass. This is why. The power of the Holy Mass is that the entire Church prays for each other and that intention. This is also how we, as the Church, pray without ceasing. Everyone moment of every day the Church is offering these intentions before the Father.

Silence is a powerful prayer often overlooked. Know that

the Church is praying for you! God's Peace,
