# Second Sunday of Advent Prepare the way of the Lord!

After the Gospel is proclaimed, the priest or deacon kisses the words of the Gospel and silently recites the prayer, "Through the words of the Gospel, may our sins be wiped away." After this short prayer a homily must be given on Sundays and other Holy Days of Obligation and recommended on other days. The homily connects the readings to the life of the parish and, with the grace of the Holy Spirit, with the people listening. So often preachers use humor and antidotes in order to make this connection. However, the Church asks that these tools only be used to serve a supporting role to the main idea of the homily. The homily should also be an appropriate length based on the culture of the parish. Fr. Richard would often say that in Ghana the homily would last for 30-45 minutes. Anything less and the people would consider the priest ill prepared. In our culture the homily usually lasts from 8-15 minutes. Anything more and the people would consider the priest long winded. A homily also looks at one idea from the readings and unfolds that one idea to gain a greater understanding and spiritual insight. This would be different from an exegesis of

the text, which is when the preacher examines the literary and historical contexts of the text and how it relates to the Sacred Scripture in total. The homily is spiritual and moral where an exegesis is educational, though the homily may have an exegetical quality to make it's point. Finally, after the homily is given, there is a period of silence to absorb the readings and any insight provided by the homily. The people reflect on how their lives are connected to the Word of God before professing our faith. God's Peace, Fr. Brian


