

# 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time



We now stand, which means we are moving, and our journey begins with Alleluia. Why do we stand? Going back to the journey analogy, we have been reading a map from the Old Testament and the New Testament. We have been seeing how God has led His people. However, now we have the Word of God, Jesus, who is "the way, the truth and the life", speaking to us in the Gospel. We no longer need to read a map, we have someone who knows the true way to the Father. "No one can come to the Father, except through me." Thus, we no longer need to read a map, now we are given directions by the ultimate GPS. This is why we begin with praise! The Greek and Hebrew word Alleluia means "give praise to God". It is a praise unique and only to God. This praise is only hindered during the Lenten Season. During this season we recall that Jesus has been trying to lead us but we, like lost sheep, have wandered from the fold. "Glory and Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ!" Like lost sheep who wander from the fold, Jesus comes to find us and bring us back into unity. This reminder lasts throughout the season of Lent, including Feasts and Solemnities when the Gloria is sung, until Easter Vigil. After our journey with the Vigil readings, psalms and prayers, after the Gloria and Epistle is read, there is an announcement. "Most Reverand Father, I bring to you a message of great joy, the message of Alleluia!" Here the Church erupts with joy and gladness as the Alleluia is announced in praise and glory! Psalm 118 is prayed, "This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice in it and be glad." The Psalm of Praise then leads the congregation to the Gospel proclamation of the Resurrection. This same hope is found every Sunday. The God's Peace,

Reminder there is no Faith Formation on **Sunday, November 26** in celebration of Thanksgiving.






Confirmation classes will be held on the first Thursday of the month.
